CIRCULAR

You are aware that Public-Private Partnerships are increasingly recognized as a valuable development tool by all stakeholders. The reason is straightforward i.e. well-designed PPP transactions have delivered quality infrastructure and services, often at lower cost, by harnessing private sector financing, technical know-how, and management expertise. It also offers an "off-budget" mechanism to pursue infrastructure projects through private investment and project-specific recovery and return on investment.

In this backdrop and for deepening of PPPs across sectors, it has been decided that all infrastructure projects with estimated project cost of more than Rs. 25 crore, proposed by various departments for inclusion in the annual plan/budget of the State, must put through a "test of amenability" for PPP and if amenable, should be implemented through PPP modality.

Therefore, all Administrative Departments or State Public Sector Undertaking(s), statutory authorities or other entities under their administrative control are hereby directed to submit all public infrastructures and social sector projects' proposal with estimated cost of more than Rs. 25 crore to the PPP Cell of Planning Department for the "test of amenability" for PPP before submitting such project proposals to Finance Department.
